AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) is a seventh through twelfth grade program that prepares students in the **academic middle** for admission to a four-year college or university. Students take an AVID elective course throughout middle school and high school that provides them with the skills needed to be successful in advancing academically with the ultimate goal of attending college. For more than 25 years AVID has been instrumental in preparing students for success in higher education.

The core component of the AVID Program is the AVID elective class. Students are taught study skills, note taking, time management, writing and research skills, while being immersed in a college-going culture. The class also includes tutoring sessions that are led by college students and provide support for success in the academically rigorous curriculum. Additionally, the AVID class provides access to information about colleges and universities through fieldtrips, guest speakers, college tutors, and college admission requirement information.

AVID recruits students who are motivated to do well and who are serious about their academic future. Based on grade point average and state test results, we feel that your child is an ideal candidate for the AVID program and has been selected to participate in the recruitment process. 
Application process:

- Thursday, April 18/Tuesday, April 23 Informational meeting for students who are eligible for participation in AVID (during tutorial in the cafeteria).
- **Thursday, April 25** Informational meeting for parents of students applying to AVID for the 2019-2020 school year (5:30 pm before open house in the cafeteria).
- Friday, April 26 Counselors present to 6th and 7th grade students regarding 2019-2020 school year.
- **Friday, May 3** Students turn in completed application with family information form and short answer form, and teachers submit recommendation form directly to Mrs. Hastings (room 16) or Mrs. Andrews (front office).
- Mid-Late May AVID applicant interviews during the school day.
- **Early June** All applicants will be notified about their acceptance to the program or if they have been placed on the wait list.
